1. GENERAL

The competition will be held in accordance with the FIA International Sporting Code (the Code), the General Regulations of the 2026 Estonian Drag Racing Championship and Cup series (General Regulations), these Supplementary Regulations and EAL regulatory documents.

To develop motor sport and involve a wider community, EAL has permitted the competition to be held in accordance with the General Regulations. In points of the General Regulations that conflict with the FIA International Sporting Code (the Code), the relevant matters shall be resolved according to the General Regulations as the higher competition regulation. In matters not regulated by the General Regulations, the Code remains the higher sporting regulatory document. EAL applies this exception in accordance with Article 1.8 of the Code.

By decision of the Board of the Estonian Autosport Union (EAL), athletes holding Russian or Belarusian citizenship are prohibited from participating in the competitions: [Restriction on Athletes with Russian and Belarusian Citizenship](#)

4.1.2 Additional classes (with description and conditions, if not covered in the general rules):

Run What Ya Brung (RWYB): Non-competition class for testing street cars (runs only in Time-Trial format). Safety requirements apply according to the personal quickest ET driven with the given vehicle. Drivers, their cars and safety equipment must comply with the RWYB rules. No competition classification is held in this class. A licence is not required, but is recommended (at minimum grassroots motorsport level). See the drag racing General Regulations, point 7.

5.3. Payment of the entry fee

The entry fee shall be paid to: EE597700771012884776, Ghost Events OÜ. In the payment description, please state the driver's first name and surname and the competition class. Example: "Enn Tamm, SG"

5.3.1 The competitor is registered when the transfer has reached the Ghost Events OÜ account no later than 09.08.2026 (inclusive). The organiser asks the entrant to take possible delays in interbank transfers into account.

5.3.2 The organiser does not guarantee the competitor access to the competition if the entry fee is received late.

5.3.3 On site, the competitor may pay the entry fee only with the organiser's consent and in cash. On site, 50.- is added to the entry fee (except for junior classes, to which the surcharge does not apply).

5.4. By registering for the competition, the participant (or, in the case of minors, their legal representative) confirms:

5.4.1 that they participate in the competition voluntarily and understand that motor sport is dangerous and involves risk to the participant's health and property. In the event of a possible accident, they will not blame the competition organisers or EAL;

5.4.2 that they have read the FIA International Sporting Code, understand it and undertake to comply with its provisions, and consent to be subject to the dispute resolution procedure and penalties set out in the FIA International Sporting Code;

5.4.3 that they have read the drag racing General Regulations, the technical regulations of drag racing and these information regulations.

6. PROTESTS AND APPEALS

6.1. Protests in accordance with point 15 of the drag racing General Regulations. The protest time is 15 minutes after the publication of the preliminary runs or eliminator results. By exception to the FIA International Sporting Code, a protest may also be lodged by a competitor (Article 13.1.1 of the FIA International Sporting Code does not apply). In all other respects, Article 13 of the FIA International Sporting Code applies. To lodge a protest, the competitor pays the protest fee within the protest time and submits the protest in writing to the Clerk of the Course.



6.1.1. The protest fee is 150 EUR. The protest fee for a protest concerning non-compliance with the technical requirements of a vehicle is 600 EUR.

The protest fee is paid in cash at the time the protest is submitted.

6.2. Appeals in accordance with point 15.7 of the drag racing General Regulations. The EAL appeal fee is 3000 euros. It is paid by bank transfer to the EAL account.
